## Weekly Covid-19 Update

Since I last contacted you on Monday 16 November, I can report that there have been no confirmed cases of Covid-19 reported to the school. As per my last email, if there are any cases which require your child to self-isolate, you will be informed immediately after an investigation is completed. If you receive no contact from the school, this means that your child can attend school as normal.

Please can I remind all parents that if your child or a member of your household develops symptoms/has gone for a test, your child MUST NOT come to school until the test result has been confirmed as negative.

If your child has a positive test for Covid-19, please can you report this to the school immediately by telephone during office hours (Monday to Thursday 8.30 – 5pm, Friday 8.30 to 4.30pm). Outside of office hours, including weekends, **please email [Covid@williamfarr.lincs.sch.uk](mailto:Covid@williamfarr.lincs.sch.uk)** and NOT the William Farr email address. Normal school absence should be reported in the usual way by telephoning the school on 01673 866900 and selecting Option 1.

This week I have had a long telephone conversation with Public Health Lincolnshire (PHL) who checked the school risk assessment (on the school website). They have reassured me that the school is following the Department for Education guidance on Covid-19 and has implemented all the required protection measures to minimise the risk of transmission. The school was commended by PHL on the safety measures in place.

I couldn't be any prouder of the staff who are working tirelessly to ensure that your child continues to be educated and supported to the very best of our ability.
