Peripatetic Music Tuition 2022-2023

I am writing to make you aware that we offer instrumental lessons on a wide range of instruments (including voice). Our instrumental teachers are all highly qualified individuals and perform on their instrument at a professional level. The school also has a superb choir and orchestra as well as many smaller musical groups, which your child may wish to get involved with. There are lots of other performance opportunities during the course of the school year. Most of our music tuition is provided by the Lincoln Music Service, however, some of our peripatetic team are self-employed and the school makes the arrangements for this on your behalf.

If you would like your child to receive instrumental lessons at William Farr School, please complete the attached form, so we can direct you to the correct teacher for your child and return it either by email to myself (see email below) or in an envelope with 'for the attention of Miss Tappin Head of Music' to the school reception. You will then receive further information about how to book.

Please be aware that subsidised lessons are offered to pupils eligible for free school meals (50%) and Looked After Children (100%)

If your child is a cathedral chorister and you wish your child to have their singing lessons in school, please can you fill in the form and return it to us just so we can make sure we allocate the right amount of time to the teacher.

Instrumental Lessons

Your child will receive 12 instrumental lessons per paid term.

Where possible lessons are rotated each week throughout the term to ensure pupils do not miss the same lesson each week.

The teacher will communicate with you either through email/text or through a practice notebook and you will receive a written report on your child's progress in the Summer Term.

Instruments are available to hire for which there will be a rental fee of £17.50 per term.

Lesson costs are non-refundable if your child misses the lesson. Teachers will reorganise the lesson for another day if they miss the lesson for any reason.

Cost of the lessons

The standard cost of tuition per term for 2022-23 is as follows:

Woodwind, Brass, Strings, Percussion, Piano, Singing and Guitar

30-minute individual lesson £18.80 per single lesson

20-minute individual lesson £12.50 per single lesson
