Dear Parent/Guardian

Lincoln: The Drill Hall – Peter Pan – Tuesday 12 December 2023

We are planning to take our Year 7 students to attend the pantomime, Peter Pan, at the Lincoln Drill Hall on Tuesday 12 December, which I hope will be a lovely end to a successful first term at William Farr School.

Coaches will leave school at 12.30pm so we will need to have an early lunch. There will be no hot food available in the school dining hall for this time, but there will be a few sandwiches and snacks available to buy. It is, therefore, recommended that students bring a packed lunch for this day.

We estimate that we will return to school at 4.30pm, meaning students will not be back at school in time to catch their normal bus. Please can you ensure that alternative arrangements are made to pick up your child from school at 4.30pm. Students who usually walk home from school are welcome to, with your permission. We ask that parents do not arrive on site before 4.15pm to allow the car park to clear from the normal dismissal. We also ask that parents park to allow the coaches access to their designated parking bays and that they drive carefully in order to prevent any safety issues for students. The school car park is likely to be very busy and students will be asked to walk to waiting cars via the pavements as much as possible.

This trip is offered as an opportunity for students to celebrate being new members of the William Farr School community. The cost to the school to provide the trip is £18.00 per student; this will include an ice-cream during the interval. Please indicate on the reply slip if your child requires a non-dairy alternative (raspberry sorbet).

In order for the trip to go ahead, we ask that all parents be willing to make a voluntary contribution of the cost per student. Cheques should be made payable to William Farr School Fund. If your child is entitled to free school meals, then please contact Mr Muir regarding possible financial support.

Students must be in full school uniform and bring the correct equipment for lessons during Periods 1, 2 and 3. Students are welcome to bring snacks with them to eat during the performance. Students not wishing to go on the trip are expected to be in school and arrangements will be made for them.

If you wish your child to attend this performance, please complete and return the reply slip to Mrs Williamson in the School Shop with payment by Monday 30 October 2023 for a guaranteed place. There cannot be an extension to this date due to ticket and ice-cream orders.
