Year 7 Visit to National Space Centre – Tuesday 23 April 2024

As part of our Key Stage 3 curriculum, the Science department is offering the opportunity for Year 7 students to visit the National Space Centre at Leicester.

The visit will take place on Tuesday 23 April 2024. The coach will leave school at 9.00am and will return at approximately 3.30pm. The cost of the visit includes coach transport to and from the Space Centre, entrance fee and an audio-visual show.

To enable the visit to take place, a minimum voluntary contribution of £24.00 is required for the trip to be viable. If your child claims free school meals, then an enquiry about financial support can be made to Mr Muir, Assistant Headteacher. Places are limited to 135; should the trip be oversubscribed, students' names will be chosen on a random basis with a senior member of staff present.

Students are advised to bring a packed lunch as we have been allocated a lunch room to eat packed lunches. Writing equipment will also be needed. Students should wear full school uniform. It is advised that mobile phones and other valuable items should not be brought on the visit.
