New Theatre Royal Lincoln – Snow White – Tuesday 17 December 2024

We are planning to take our Year 7 students to attend the pantomime, Snow White, at the New Theatre Royal on Tuesday 17 December, which I hope will be a lovely end to a successful first term at William Farr School. Coaches will leave school at 10.00am and will return to school around 2:00pm, therefore students will need to bring a morning snack and a packed lunch with them. They will be able to eat their lunch during the interval at the theatre. This trip is offered as an opportunity for students to celebrate being new members of the William Farr School community. The cost to the school to provide the trip is **£19.00 per student**. This will include the cost of the tickets for the pantomime and the coach transport to the theatre and back to school. Students must be in full school uniform and bring the correct equipment for their Period 1, 4 and 5 lessons. Students not wishing to go on the trip are expected to be in school and arrangements will be made for them.

Under the Education Reform Act, we can only raise the cost of this visit through a voluntary contribution, therefore, in order for this visit to take place, we ask that parents are willing to make a voluntary contribution to cover the cost. If your child qualifies for Pupil Premium or is currently in receipt of free school meals, please see the letter which was sent out in October by Mr Muir, Assistant Headteacher, which explains about applying for financial support in relation to educational visits.

If you wish your child to attend this performance, please complete and return the reply slip to Mrs Williamson in the School Shop with payment **by Thursday 21 November 2024** for a guaranteed place. There cannot be an extension to this date due to ticket orders. The school reserves the right to withdraw any student from an educational visit if the student repeatedly displays poor standards of behaviour in school and it is considered that this behaviour would pose a serious Health and Safety risk on an educational visit.
