Summer Term Letter

Now that the final countdown to A Level's is well underway, I wanted to confirm some details regarding study leave, exams, Prom and results day in August.

Leavers Day

Year 13s final day in school will be Wednesday 6 May. Students will be off timetable during this day to partake in a range of celebratory activities. The timetable for the day is as follows:

<i>Period 1</i>	-	Church Service.
<i>Period 2/3</i>	-	Whole Year group activities in the Main Hall
<i>Lunch</i>	-	Stalls and food trucks on the field.
<i>Period 4/5</i>	-	Whole Year group activities on the field.

Leavers' Day is a really positive experience for all students in the school. I will remind students of our expectations in an assembly. Please can I remind you that students who bring any banned items into school or are involved or associated with any activity involving banned items, will be sent home.

Examination Leave

Students are not expected to be in school from **Thursday 7 May**. However, in the two weeks prior to half term teachers will be available during the usual lesson timetable to support students. This could be via email, or face to face. However, students are not expected to be in school full time during this period. I actively encourage students to use this time to study privately at home, using school for support where needed.

Exams

A Level examinations start on 11 May. Students should familiarise themselves with their timetable. Students are only required to be in school for their examinations. The exams contingency day is Wednesday 24 June. This is a day set aside by exam boards should there be significant local or national disruption to exams during which no students (or a large number of them) are able to take an exam when planned.

Returning school property

We acknowledge that students will wish to keep their textbooks for as long as possible. Once students have finished with their textbooks they should return them to the Library. Lanyards should be returned to Mrs Williamson in the Finance Department


Results Day
